Requirements

- Current PT, PTA, or student membership in APTA Idaho.
- Willingness and ability to devote approximately four hours per month to program activities, which will include strengths-assessment, bi-weekly meetings with mentors, and research assignments. Activities during the Fall Conference will require a longer time commitment.
- Desire and ability to choose a volunteer role in the Chapter upon completion of the program.
